- MATERIALS NEED 1. Snacks and drinks
 - Computer, ipad, Kindle or Phone to share a YouTube video
 - 3. Bible



WE WELCOME

1. Gather your family together again in a comfortable place. If you are alone, you can also use this information, or invite a friend to share with you on Zoom. Provide a light snack and a drink to aid creating a sense of community.

WE GATHER

- 1. Now that you have gathered together, pass out your snacks and drinks.
- 2. Can you name two examples of God's generosity in your life in the past month? Share your thoughts with your group.
- 3. Are there some uncommon places you can look for God's generosity in the world? For example, do you see it on TV, or when you are walking down the street? If so, share some of these uncommon places and what areas of generosity that you witnessed.

WE HEAR

- 1. Share YouTube video called "Eating Twinkies with God" (be sure to skip the ad at the beginning): https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=y9N8OXkN0Rk
- 2. The young boy in the video is looking for God. How do you look for God, and what ways can you share generosity with others? Name one area where you can be generous to someone in the next week.

WE SHARE

1. Get out your Bible and read 2 Corinthians 9:6. Think to yourself of times you have sowed sparingly. If you are comfortable sharing, give some examples. Where have you sowed generously? Share examples, and what it made you feel like to do that.

WE SEND

LIGHT OF CHRIST

Invite someone to light the candle as the leader says: We light the candle as a reminder that we are the light of Christ. May we reflect God's grace and generosity from generation to generation, at home, at school, at work and in church.

WE LIVE

Pray together for the week ahead asking for opportunities to demonstrate generosity.
