WE WELCOME

Gather your family together again in a comfortable place. If you are alone, you can also use this information, or invite a friend to share with you on Zoom. Provide a light snack and a drink to aid creating a sense of community. Light the candle.

WE GATHER

- 1. Now that you have gathered, distribute your snacks and drinks.
- Can you name two examples of God's generosity in your life in the past month? Share your thoughts with your group.
- 3. Can you name an example of where you have seen God's generosity in someone else's life? Can you share with the group how you knew you could see this?



WE HEAR

- 1. Watch the video and listen carefully to the lyrics: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nF3yJg45NZY</u> (be sure to skip the opening advertisement).
- 2. The vocalist sings "it is an emergency". Do you feel the need for generosity in an emergency? Share your thoughts as to why or why not. Give examples.
- 3. The vocalist also sings about needing a miracle. Is the miracle needed: Jesus, you or something else? Share your thoughts.

WE SHARE

Open your Bibles to 1 Timothy 6:17 and read aloud.

WE SEND

LIGHT OF CHRIST

Invite someone to light the candle and say: "We light the candle as a reminder that we are the light of Christ. May we reflect God's grace and generosity from generation to generation, at home, at school, at work and in church."

WE LIVE

Pray together for the week ahead asking for opportunities to demonstrate generosity.
